

**AMENDMENT TO RULES**  
**COMMITTEE PRINT 119-8**  
**OFFERED BY MRS. SYKES OF OHIO**

At the end of subtitle A of title VI, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 6\_\_\_ . CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS FOR PAY AND**  
2 **ALLOWANCES FOR MEMBERS OF THE ARMED**  
3 **FORCES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—There are appropriated for a fis-  
5 cal year, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise  
6 appropriated for such fiscal year, for any period during  
7 which interim or full-year appropriations for such fiscal  
8 year are not in effect, such sums as are necessary to pro-  
9 vide pay and allowances to—

10 (1) members of the Armed Forces, including  
11 the reserve components thereof, who perform active  
12 service or inactive-duty training during such period;

13 (2) civilian employees of the Department of De-  
14 fense (and the Department of Homeland Security in  
15 the case of the Coast Guard when the Coast Guard  
16 is not operating as a service in the Department of  
17 the Navy) whom the Secretary concerned determines

1 are providing support to members of the Armed  
2 Forces described in paragraph (1); and

3 (3) contractors of the Department of Defense  
4 (and the Department of Homeland Security in the  
5 case of the Coast Guard when the Coast Guard is  
6 not operating as a service in the Department of the  
7 Navy) whom the Secretary concerned determines are  
8 providing support to members of the Armed Forces  
9 described in paragraph (1).

10 (b) TERMINATION.—Appropriations and funds made  
11 available and authority granted pursuant to this section  
12 shall be available until the first of the following occurs:

13 (1) The enactment into law of an appropriation  
14 (including a continuing appropriation) for any pur-  
15 pose for which amounts are made available in sub-  
16 section (a).

17 (2) The enactment into law of the applicable  
18 regular or continuing appropriations resolution or  
19 other Act without any appropriation for such pur-  
20 pose.

21 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

22 (1) The terms “active service”, “Armed  
23 Forces”, and “inactive-duty training” have the  
24 meanings given such terms in section 101 of title 10,  
25 United States Code.

1           (2) The term “reserve components” means the  
2 components named in section 10101 of title 10,  
3 United States Code.

4           (3) The term “Secretary concerned” means—

5                 (A) the Secretary of Defense with respect  
6 to the Department of Defense; and

7                 (B) the Secretary of Homeland Security  
8 with respect to matters concerning the Coast  
9 Guard when the Coast Guard is not operating  
10 as a service in the Department of the Navy.
