15	Restoration Act of 2003 (16 U.S.C. 6511(1)).
16	(2) Collaboration.—In carrying out the as-
17	sessment required under paragraph (1), the Sec-
18	retary of Defense, acting through the Director of the

1 Defense Logistics Agency, and the Secretary of Ag-2 riculture, acting through the Chief of the Forest 3 Service, shall consult with State foresters and par-4 ticipants in the programs described in such para-5 graph. 6 (b) Report.—Not later than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense, acting through the Director of the Defense Logistics 8 Agency, jointly with the Secretary of Agriculture, acting 10 through the Chief of the Forest Service, shall submit to the Committee on Armed Services and the Committee on 12 Agriculture of the House of Representatives and the Committee on Armed Services and the Committee on Agri-14 culture, Forestry, and Nutrition of the Senate a report 15 on the assessment required under paragraph (1) of sub-16 section (a) and any findings and recommendations with respect to the programs described in such paragraph.
