

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118-**

**OFFERED BY MS. HOULAHAN OF PENNSYLVANIA**

At the end of subtitle F of title VIII, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 8\_\_\_. REPORTS ON SMALL BUSINESS CONCERNS.**

2 (a) REPORT ON SMALL BUSINESS CONCERNS  
3 OWNED AND CONTROLLED BY WOMEN.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 8(m) of the Small  
5 Business Act (15 U.S.C. 637(m)) is amended by  
6 adding at the end the following:

7 “(9) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the  
8 date of enactment of this paragraph, and annually  
9 thereafter, the Administrator shall submit to the  
10 Committee on Small Business and Entrepreneurship  
11 of the Senate and the Committee on Small Business  
12 of the House of Representatives a report on small  
13 business concerns owned and controlled by women,  
14 which shall include, for the fiscal year preceding the  
15 date of the report, the following:

16 “(A) The number of applications for cer-  
17 tification as a small business concern owned  
18 and controlled by women that have sufficient

1 information for the Administrator to make a  
2 certification determination, disaggregated by—

3 “(i) the number of applications cer-  
4 tified;

5 “(ii) the number of applications de-  
6 nied; and

7 “(iii) the number of applications for  
8 which a determination has not been made.

9 “(B) The number of concerns certified as  
10 small business concerns owned and controlled  
11 by women by a national certifying entity ap-  
12 proved by the Administrator.

13 “(C) The amount of fees, if any, charged  
14 by each national certifying entity for the certifi-  
15 cation described in subparagraph (B).

16 “(D) The total dollar amount and total  
17 percentage of prime contracts awarded to small  
18 business concerns owned and controlled by  
19 women pursuant to paragraph (2) or pursuant  
20 to a waiver granted under paragraph (3).

21 “(E) The total dollar amount and total  
22 percentage of prime contracts awarded to small  
23 business concerns owned and controlled by  
24 women pursuant to paragraph (7) or (8).

1           “(F) With respect to a contract incorrectly  
2 awarded pursuant to this subsection because it  
3 was awarded based on an industry in which  
4 small business concerns owned and controlled  
5 by women are not underrepresented—

6                   “(i) the number of such contracts;

7                   “(ii) the Federal agencies that issued  
8 such contracts; and

9                   “(iii) any steps taken by the Adminis-  
10 trator to train the personnel of each Fed-  
11 eral agency described in clause (ii) on the  
12 use of the authority provided under this  
13 subsection.

14           “(G) With respect to an examination de-  
15 scribed in paragraph (5)(B)—

16                   “(i) the number of examinations due  
17 because of recertification requirements and  
18 the actual number of examinations con-  
19 ducted; and

20                   “(ii) the number of examinations con-  
21 ducted for any other reason.

22           “(H) The number of small business con-  
23 cerns owned and controlled by women that were  
24 found to be ineligible to be awarded a contract  
25 under this subsection as a result of an examina-

1           tion conducted pursuant to paragraph (5)(B) or  
2           failure to request an examination pursuant to  
3           section 127.400 of title 13, Code of Federal  
4           Regulations, or any successor regulation.

5           “(I) The number of small business con-  
6           cerns owned and controlled by women that were  
7           decertified.

8           “(J) The total number of small business  
9           concerns owned and controlled by women.

10          “(K) Any other information the Adminis-  
11          trator determines necessary.”.

12          (2)       TECHNICAL        AMENDMENT.—Section  
13          8(m)(2)(C) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.  
14          637(m)(2)(C)) is amended by striking “paragraph  
15          (3)” and inserting “paragraph (4)”.

16          (b)   REPORT ON SMALL BUSINESS CONCERNS  
17   OWNED AND CONTROLLED BY QUALIFIED HUBZONE  
18   SMALL BUSINESS CONCERNS.—Section 31 of the Small  
19   Business Act (15 U.S.C. 657a) is amended—

20           (1) by redesignating subsection (f) as sub-  
21           section (g); and

22           (2) by inserting after subsection (e) the fol-  
23           lowing:

24           “(f) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date  
25           of enactment of this subsection, and annually thereafter,

1 the Administrator shall submit to the Committee on Small  
2 Business and Entrepreneurship of the Senate and the  
3 Committee on Small Business of the House of Representa-  
4 tives a report on HUBZone small business concerns, which  
5 shall include, for the fiscal year preceding the date of the  
6 report, the following:

7           “(1) The number of applications for certifi-  
8 cation as a qualified HUBZone small business con-  
9 cern that have sufficient information for the Admin-  
10 istrator to make a certification determination,  
11 disaggregated by—

12                   “(A) the number of applications certified;

13                   “(B) the number of applications denied;

14           and

15                   “(C) the number of applications for which  
16 a determination has not been made.

17           “(2) The total dollar amount and total percent-  
18 age of prime contracts awarded to qualified  
19 HUBZone small business concerns pursuant to this  
20 section.

21           “(3) The total dollar amount and percent of  
22 sole source contracts awarded to qualified HUBZone  
23 small business concerns under subsection (c)(2)(A).

24           “(4) With respect to an examination described  
25 in subsection (d)(5)—

1           “(A) the number of examinations due be-  
2           cause of recertification requirements and the  
3           actual number of examinations conducted; and

4           “(B) the number of examinations con-  
5           ducted for any other reason.

6           “(5) The number of HUBZone small business  
7           concerns that were found to be ineligible to be  
8           awarded a contract under this subsection as a result  
9           of an examination conducted pursuant to subsection  
10          (d)(5) or a verification conducted pursuant to sub-  
11          section (d)(2).

12          “(6) The number of small business concerns  
13          that were decertified as qualified HUBZone small  
14          business concerns.

15          “(7) The number of qualified HUBZone small  
16          business concerns.

17          “(8) Any other information the Administrator  
18          determines necessary.”.

19          (c) REPORT ON SMALL BUSINESS CONCERNS OWNED  
20          AND CONTROLLED BY SERVICE-DISABLED VETERANS.—

21          Section 36 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 657f)  
22          is amended by adding at the end the following:

23          “(j) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date  
24          of enactment of this subsection, and annually thereafter,  
25          the Administrator shall submit to the Committee on Small

1 Business and Entrepreneurship of the Senate and the  
2 Committee on Small Business of the House of Representa-  
3 tives a report on small business concerns owned and con-  
4 trolled by service-disabled veterans, which shall include,  
5 for the fiscal year preceding the date of the report, the  
6 following:

7           “(1) The total number of small business con-  
8           cerns certified as small business concerns owned and  
9           controlled by service-disabled veterans.

10           “(2) The total dollar amount and total percent-  
11           age of prime contracts awarded to small business  
12           concerns owned and controlled by service-disabled  
13           veterans pursuant to this section.

14           “(3) The total dollar amount and percent of  
15           sole source contracts awarded to small business con-  
16           cerns owned and controlled by service-disabled vet-  
17           erans pursuant to subsection (c).

18           “(4) With respect to an examination described  
19           in subsection (h)(2)—

20                   “(A) the number of examinations due be-  
21                   cause of recertification requirements and the  
22                   actual number of such examinations conducted;  
23                   and

24                   “(B) the number of examinations con-  
25                   ducted for any other reason.

1           “(5) The number of small business concerns  
2 owned and controlled by service-disabled veterans  
3 that were found to be ineligible to be awarded a con-  
4 tract under this subsection as a result of an exam-  
5 ination conducted pursuant to subsection (h)(2).

6           “(6) The number of small business concerns de-  
7 certified as small business concerns owned and con-  
8 trolled by service-disabled veterans.

9           “(7) The total number of small business con-  
10 cerns owned and controlled by service-disabled vet-  
11 erans.

12           “(8) Any other information the Administrator  
13 determines necessary.”.
