

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119–16

OFFERED BY MR. MASSIE OF KENTUCKY

At the end of subtitle D of title XII, insert the following:

**SEC.12__. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS FOR ISRAELI
COOPERATIVE MISSILE DEFENSE PROGRAMS.**

(a) PROHIBITION.—None of the funds authorized to be appropriated by this Act or otherwise made available for the Department of Defense for fiscal year 2026 may be used for Israeli cooperative missile defense programs, including the Iron Dome short-range rocket defense system, Arrow 3 Upper Tier Interceptor Program, and the David’s Sling Weapon System.

(b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

(1) ARROW 3 UPPER TIER SYSTEMS.—Notwithstanding the amounts set forth in the funding tables in division D, the amount authorized to be appropriated in section 101 for Procurement, Defense-wide, Major Equipment, Missile Defense Agency, as specified in the corresponding funding table in section 4101, for Arrow 3 Upper Tier Systems is hereby reduced by \$100,000,000.

(2) SHORT RANGE BALLISTIC MISSILE DEFENSE.—Notwithstanding the amounts set forth in the funding tables in division D, the amount authorized to be appropriated in section 101 for Procurement, Defense-wide, Major Equipment, Missile Defense Agency, as specified in the corresponding funding table in section 4101, for Short Range Ballistic Missile Defense (SRBMD) is hereby reduced by \$40,000,000.

(3) IRON DOME.—Notwithstanding the amounts set forth in the funding tables in division D, the amount authorized to be appropriated

in section 101 for Procurement, Defense-wide, Major Equipment, Missile Defense Agency, as specified in the corresponding funding table in section 4101, for Iron Dome is hereby reduced by \$60,000,000.

(4) ISRAELI COOPERATIVE PROGRAMS.—

Notwithstanding the amounts set forth in the funding tables in division D, the amount authorized to be appropriated in section 201 for Research, Test, Development, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, Advance Component Development and Prototype, as specified in the corresponding funding table in section 4201, for Israeli Cooperative Programs is hereby reduced by \$300,000,000.
