## AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO S. 2372 OFFERED BY MR. TAKANO OF CALIFORNIA

Add at the end of section 510 the following:

1 (c) Changes in Concepts and Definitions.— 2 (1) In general.—The authorizations of appro-3 priations made by this section shall be considered changes in concepts and definitions pursuant to sec-5 tion 251(b)(1) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (2 U.S.C. 6 7 901(b)(1)). These changes shall be reflected only in 8 the budget vear in each sequestration preview report 9 required by section 254(c) of such Act. For each 10 budget year, the baseline level of new budget author-11 ity using up-to-date concepts and definitions shall be 12 equal to the discretionary appropriations that are 13 specified for those authorizations of appropriations 14 in the budget that the President submits under sec-15 tion 1105 of title 31, United States Code, including 16 those already provided for that fiscal year as ad-17 vance discretionary new budget authority.

(2) Adjustment of fiscal year 2019 discre-

TIONARY SPENDING LIMITS.— Within 15 days of the

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1 publication of a final rule in the Federal Register 2 promulgating the regulations pursuant to section 3 101(c) of this Act, the Office of Management and 4 Budget shall further adjust the fiscal year 2019 dis-5 cretionary spending limits to reflect the impact of 6 those regulations, as estimated by the Department 7 of Veterans Affairs, on the discretionary appropria-8 tions that are specified for those authorizations of 9 appropriations in the Budget that the President sub-10 mitted for that fiscal year under section 1105 of 11 title 31 United States Code, and shall provide writ-12 ten notification to the Congress of such further ad-13 justments.

(3) Report to congress.—Not later than 10 days after the date each year on which the President submits the budget request under section 1105 of title 31 United States Code, and also 10 days after the publication of the final rule previously referenced in this section, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall submit to the Committees on Appropriations of both Houses of Congress a report detailing the estimates of the resources required by the Department for those authorizations of appropriations, as forecast using the Enrollee Health Care Projections

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Model, or other methodologies used by the Depart-

2 ment. 3 (4) Adjustment of future discretionary 4 SPENDING LIMITS.—For each fiscal year, the Office 5 of Management and Budget shall further adjust the discretionary spending limits in section 251(c) of the 6 7 Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control 8 Act of 1985 (2 U.S.C. 901(c)) to reflect the trans-9 mittal of any formal and informal supplementals and 10 amendments, as those terms are defined in section 11 110 of Office of Management and Budget Circular A-11, for those authorizations of appropriations and 12 13 shall provide written notification to the Congress of 14 such further adjustments within 15 days of such 15 transmittal.
