## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT FOR H.R. 6395

## OFFERED BY MR. TAKANO OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of subtitle B of title IX, add the following:

1	SEC LIMITATION ON CONSOLIDATION OR TRANSI-
2	TION TO ALTERNATIVE CONTENT DELIVERY
3	METHODS WITHIN THE DEFENSE MEDIA AC-
4	TIVITY.
5	(a) In General.—No consolidation or transition to
6	alternative content delivery methods may occur within the
7	Defense Media Activity until a period of 180 days has
8	elapsed following the date on which the Secretary of De-
9	fense submits to the congressional defense committees a
10	report that includes a certification, in detail, that such
11	consolidation or transition to alternative content delivery
12	methods will not—
13	(1) compromise the safety and security of mem-
14	bers of the Armed Forces and their families;
15	(2) compromise the cybersecurity or security of
16	content delivery to members of the Armed Forces,
17	whether through—

1	(A) inherent vulnerabilities in the content
2	delivery method concerned;
3	(B) vulnerabilities in the personal devices
4	used by members; or
5	(C) vulnerabilities in the receivers or
6	streaming devices necessary to accommodate
7	the alternative content delivery method;
8	(3) increase monetary costs or personal finan-
9	cial liabilities to members of the Armed Forces or
10	their families, whether through monthly subscription
11	fees or other tolls required to access digital content;
12	and
13	(4) impede access to content due to bandwidth
14	or other technical limitations where members of the
15	Armed Forces receive content.
16	(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
17	(1) The term "alternative content delivery"
18	means any method of the Defense Media Activity for
19	the delivery of digital content that is different from
20	a method used by the Activity as of the date of the
21	enactment of this Act.
22	(2) The term "consolidation", when used with
23	respect to the Defense Media Activity, means any
24	action to reduce or limit the functions, personnel, fa-
25	cilities, or capabilities of the Activity, including en-

- 1 tering into contracts or developing plans for such re-
- 2 duction or limitation.
