At the end of subtitle C of title XVII, add the following:

SEC. 17_. REPORT ON EFFORTS TO STOP IRAN FROM DE VELOPING A NUCLEAR WEAPON. (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the

5 in consultation with the Secretary of Defense, shall submit
6 to the appropriate congressional committees a report that

- 8 (1) United States-led efforts to stop the Islamic

- 11 (A) sanctions and enforcement with respect12 to Iran;
- 13 (B) coordination with United States allies14 and partners; and
- 15 (C) negotiations with Iran; and
 16 (2) efforts of the Department of State and De17 partment of Defense to work with United States al18 lies and partners to inform them of the threat posed

by the Islamic Republic of Iran in its efforts to de velop a nuclear weapon.

3 (b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—The report required
4 by subsection (a) shall not be considered compliance with
5 any of the requirements contained in section 135 of the
6 Atomic Energy Act of 1954 (42 U.S.C. 2160e).

7 (c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)
8 shall be submitted in unclassified form but may contain
9 a classified annex.

10 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES
11 DEFINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate con12 gressional committees" means—

(1) the Committee on Armed Services and the
Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate; and
(2) the Committee on Armed Services and the
Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Representatives.
