2 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland 3 Security may waive, on a case-by-case basis, and for 4 a period of not more than one year, the application 5 of subsection (b) to an institution of higher edu-6 cation if the Secretary determines such waiver is in 7 the national security interests of the United States. 8 (2) RENEWAL.—The Secretary of Homeland 9 Security may annually renew a waiver issued pursu-10 ant to paragraph (1) if the Secretary determines

11 such waiver is in the national security interests of12 the United States.

13 (3) NOTIFICATION.—If the Secretary of Home-14 land Security issues or renews a waiver pursuant to 15 paragraph (1) or (2), respectively, not later than 30 16 days after such issuance or renewal, as the case may 17 be, the Secretary shall provide written notification to 18 the Committee on Homeland Security of the House 19 of Representatives and the Committee on Homeland 20 Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate re-

- 1 garding such issuance or renewal, including a jus-
- 2 tification relating thereto.
