## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117–13

## OFFERED BY MS. TITUS OF NEVADA

Add at the end of title XVI of subtitle C the following:

1	SEC. 1649. SENSE OF CONGRESS AGAINST CONDUCTING EX-
2	PLOSIVE NUCLEAR TESTS.
3	(a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds the following:
4	(1) Over the last 28 years, the National Nu-
5	clear Security Administration (NNSA) of the De-
6	partment of Energy and its nuclear weapons labora-
7	tories have certified that our nuclear weapons stock-
8	pile remains safe, secure, and reliable without con-
9	ducting live explosive tests.
10	(2) Our nuclear weapons lab directors have as-
11	sessed that the United States knows more about our
12	nuclear stockpile through the Stockpile Stewardship
13	Program than we did during the era of testing.
14	(3) Since 1992, Republican and Democratic ad-
15	ministrations have abided by a moratorium on explo-
16	sive nuclear testing in the United States.
17	(4) The Trump administration's 2018 Nuclear
18	Posture Review makes clear that "the United States

1	will not resume nuclear explosive testing unless nec-
2	essary to ensure the safety and effectiveness of the
3	U.S. nuclear arsenal".
4	(b) Sense of Congress.—It is the sense of Con-
5	gress that—
6	(1) the United States can continue to ensure
7	the safety and reliability of our nuclear stockpile
8	without explosive nuclear testing;
9	(2) explosive nuclear testing by the United
10	States will open the door to widespread global test-
11	ing and undoubtedly put the United States and the
12	world at greater risk; and
13	(3) resumption of explosive nuclear testing
14	would impose immense financial and health costs or
15	the American people.
