

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT**  
**118–36**  
**OFFERED BY MS. TITUS OF NEVADA**

At the end of subtitle C of title XVII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . ESTABLISHMENT OF INTERAGENCY WORKING**  
2 **GROUP.**

3 (a) **ESTABLISHMENT.**—Not later than 90 days after  
4 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of Na-  
5 tional Intelligence shall establish a working group (in this  
6 section referred to as the “Working Group”) to develop  
7 and maintain a public database as described in subsection  
8 (c).

9 (b) **MEMBERSHIP.**—As determined appropriate by  
10 the Director, the composition of the Working Group may  
11 include any officer or employee of—

12 (1) the Bureau of Intelligence and Research of  
13 the Department of State;

14 (2) the Federal Bureau of Investigation;

15 (3) the National Security Division of the De-  
16 partment of Justice;

17 (4) the Committee on Foreign Investment in  
18 the United States;

1 (5) the Office of the Director of National Intel-  
2 ligence;

3 (6) the Bureau of Political-Military Affairs of  
4 the Department of State;

5 (7) the Bureau of Industry and Security of the  
6 Department of Commerce; and

7 (8) any other government office or department  
8 that the Director determines appropriate.

9 (c) PUBLIC DATABASE DEADLINE AND REQUIRE-  
10 MENTS.—The Working Group shall, not later than 1 year  
11 after the date that the Working Group is established  
12 under subsection (a), develop, maintain, and make publicly  
13 available a searchable database with respect to any known  
14 or identifiable connections between any covered entity and  
15 any Chinese company, investment firm, or other financial  
16 institution, research institute, or university.

17 (d) COVERED ENTITY.—In this section, the term  
18 “covered entity” means any of the following:

19 (1) The military of the People’s Republic of  
20 China, including the People’s Liberation Army and  
21 the Central Military Commission.

22 (2) The United Front Work Department of the  
23 People’s Republic of China, as well as other Chinese  
24 Communist Party organizations and Chinese govern-

1        ment agencies known to carry out united front ac-  
2        tivities.

3            (3) Any security service or intelligence agency  
4        of the People's Republic of China, including the  
5        Ministry of Public Security and the Ministry of  
6        State Security.

7            (4) Other organizations with ties to Chinese  
8        government entities known to carry out state-spon-  
9        sored technology transfer activities, talent recruit-  
10       ment programs, and supervision of military-civil fu-  
11       sion industrial plans or partnerships with academic  
12       institutions.
