

**AMENDMENT TO THE SENATE AMENDMENT TO**  
**H.R. 1**  
**OFFERED BY MS. TITUS OF NEVADA**

At the end of title III, add the following new section:

1   **SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. HOUSING VOUCHERS FAIRNESS.**

2           Section 8(o) of the United States Housing Act of  
3   1937 (42 U.S.C. 1437f(o)) is amended by adding at the  
4   end the following:

5                   “(23) RENTAL VOUCHERS FOR HIGH GROWTH  
6           POPULATION AREAS.—

7                   “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall,  
8                   each year, using amounts appropriated pursu-  
9                   ant to subparagraph (B), provide additional as-  
10                  sistance in an equitable manner to each eligible  
11                  public housing agency for tenant-based assist-  
12                  ance, based on the population in the area  
13                  served by the public housing agency, the extent  
14                  to which existing voucher allocations of the eli-  
15                  gible public housing agency do not meet its  
16                  housing affordability needs, and historical  
17                  shortfalls in providing assistance to such eligi-  
18                  ble public housing agency as a result of voucher  
19                  formula allocations not keeping pace with popu-

1           lation growth over the period identified in sub-  
2           paragraph (C)(ii).

3           “(B) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIA-  
4           TIONS.—There are authorized to be appro-  
5           priated to Secretary to carry out this paragraph  
6           \$2,000,000,000 for fiscal year 2026, which  
7           shall be available for renewals in each fiscal  
8           year thereafter until expended.

9           “(C) ELIGIBLE FOR PUBLIC HOUSING  
10          AGENCY DEFINED.—For the purposes of this  
11          paragraph, the term ‘eligible public housing  
12          agency’ means a public housing agency that ad-  
13          ministers Federal housing assistance for an  
14          area that, as determined by the Secretary—

15               “(i) has a population of greater than  
16               100,000; and

17               “(ii) is one of 25 areas in the United  
18               States that experienced the highest popu-  
19               lation growth between 2012 to 2022.”.
