

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT**  
**119–8**  
**OFFERED BY MS. TITUS OF NEVADA**

At the appropriate place in subtitle B of title XVII,  
insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 17\_\_\_\_. ESTABLISHMENT OF INTERAGENCY WORKING**  
2 **GROUP AND DATABASE ON CONNECTIONS**  
3 **BETWEEN COVERED ENTITIES AND CERTAIN**  
4 **FOREIGN INSTITUTIONS.**

5 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—Not later than 90 days after  
6 the date of the enactment of this section, the Director of  
7 National Intelligence shall establish a working group (in  
8 this section referred to as the “Working Group”) to de-  
9 velop and maintain a public database as described in sub-  
10 section (c).

11 (b) MEMBERSHIP.—As determined appropriate by  
12 the Director, the composition of the Working Group may  
13 include any officer or employee of—

14 (1) the Bureau of Intelligence and Research of  
15 the Department of State;

16 (2) the Federal Bureau of Investigation;

17 (3) the National Security Division of the De-  
18 partment of Justice;

1 (4) the Committee on Foreign Investment in  
2 the United States;

3 (5) the Office of the Director of National Intel-  
4 ligence;

5 (6) the Bureau of Political-Military Affairs of  
6 the Department of State;

7 (7) the Bureau of Industry and Security of the  
8 Department of Commerce; and

9 (8) any other government office or department  
10 that the Director determines appropriate.

11 (c) PUBLIC DATABASE DEADLINE AND REQUIRE-  
12 MENTS.—The Working Group shall, not later than one  
13 year after the date that the Working Group is established  
14 under subsection (a), develop, maintain, and make publicly  
15 available a searchable database with respect to any known  
16 or identifiable connections between any covered entity and  
17 any Chinese company, investment firm, or other financial  
18 institution, research institute, or university.

19 (d) COVERED ENTITY.—In this section, the term  
20 “covered entity” means any of the following:

21 (1) The military of the People’s Republic of  
22 China, including the People’s Liberation Army and  
23 the Central Military Commission.

24 (2) The United Front Work Department of the  
25 People’s Republic of China, as well as other Chinese

1 Communist Party organizations and Chinese govern-  
2 ment agencies known to carry out united front ac-  
3 tivities.

4 (3) Any security service or intelligence agency  
5 of the People's Republic of China, including the  
6 Ministry of Public Security and the Ministry of  
7 State Security.

8 (4) Other organizations with ties to Chinese  
9 government entities known to carry out state-spon-  
10 sored technology transfer activities, talent recruit-  
11 ment programs, and supervision of military-civil fu-  
12 sion industrial plans or partnerships with academic  
13 institutions.
