Page 228, after line 22, insert the following:

1 (6) The understanding of the health and envi-
2 ronmental impacts of PFAS on disproportionately
3 exposed communities, including demographic infor-
4 mation on the race and income level of communities
5 impacted by PFAS.

6 (f) DISPROPORTIONATELY EXPOSED COMMUNITY
7 DEFINED.—In this section, the term “disproportionately
8 exposed community” means a community in which climate
9 change, pollution, or environmental destruction have exac-
10 erbated systemic racial, regional, social, environmental,
11 and economic injustices by disproportionately affecting in-
12 digenous peoples, communities of color, migrant commu-
13 nities, deindustrialized communities, depopulated rural
14 communities, the poor, low-income workers, women, the
15 elderly, people experiencing homelessness, people with dis-
16 abilities, people who are incarcerated, or youth.
