6	(a) In General.—Sections 1819(b)(5) and
7	1919(b)(5) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395i–
8	3(b)(5), $1396r(b)(5)$) are each amended—
9	(1) in subparagraph $(A)(i)(I)$, by inserting "(or,
10	in the case of a specified individual (as defined in
11	subparagraph (H)(ii)), meets the requirement de-
12	scribed in subparagraph $(H)(i)$)" after "subsection
13	(e)(1)(A)"; and
14	(2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
15	paragraph:
16	"(H) COVID-19 TRAINING AND COM-
17	PETENCY REQUIREMENT FLEXIBILITY.—
18	"(i) In general.—For purposes of
19	subparagraph (A)(i)(I), the requirement

1	described in this clause is, with respect to
2	a specified individual (as defined in clause
3	(ii)), that the individual demonstrates com-
4	petency in work as a nursing aide
5	through—
6	"(I) the successful completion of
7	a nursing aide examination approved
8	by the State;
9	"(II) certification of competency
10	by a site administrator of a nursing
11	aide apprenticeship program approved
12	by the State; or
13	"(III) an assessment by the facil-
14	ity in each of the areas and skills de-
15	scribed in section 583.152(b) of title
16	42, Code of Federal Regulations (or a
17	successor regulation).
18	"(ii) Specified individual de-
19	FINED.—For purposes of this subpara-
20	graph, the term 'specified individual'
21	means an individual who, during the emer-
22	gency period described in section
23	1135(g)(1)(B)—
24	"(I) completed a nursing aide
25	training program and competency as-

1	sessment (whether online or other-
2	wise) approved by the State; and
3	"(II) completed a minimum of 80
4	hours of work as a temporary nurse
5	aide, in supervised practical nurse
6	aide training, in on-the-job nursing
7	aide training, or in in-service nursing
8	aide education, under the supervision
9	of a registered nurse or a licensed
10	practical nurse.".
11	(b) Inclusion on Registry.—Section
12	1819(e)(2)(A) and 1919(e)(2)(A) of the Social Security
13	Act (42 U.S.C. $1395i-3(e)(2)(A)$, $1396r(e)(2)(A)$) are
14	each amended by inserting ", or any specified individual
15	(as defined in clause (ii) of subsection (b)(5)(H)(ii)) who
16	meets the requirement described in clause (i) of such sub-
17	section" before the period at the end.
18	(c) Educational and Outreach Activities.—
19	The Secretary of Health and Human Services shall under-
20	take outreach and educational activities for purposes of
21	informing States of—
22	(1) the effects of the amendments made by this
23	section; and
24	(2) what actions States may take with respect
25	to the training and assessment of nursing aides in

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- 1 such State that will comply with the provisions of
- 2 such amendments.
