

AMENDMENT TO THE
SENATE AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1
OFFERED BY MS. TOKUDA

At the end of title I, add the following new section:

SEC. __. PROTECTION OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCERS FROM ECONOMIC LOSSES.

- (a) Certification.—Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, no provision of this title, shall take effect unless the Secretary of Agriculture, in consultation with the Chief Economist of the Department of Agriculture, certifies that such provision or amendment will not result in material adverse economic impact on agricultural producers in the United States.
- (b) Definition.—For purposes of this section, the term “material adverse economic impact” means any projected reduction in net income, market prices, or demand for agricultural commodities or products that is likely to cause significant financial harm to a substantial number of agricultural producers.
- (c) Report.—The Secretary of Agriculture shall submit to Congress, not later than 60 days before the effective date of any provision or amendment described in subsection (1), a detailed report including
 - (1) The basis for the certification described in subsection (a);
 - (2) An analysis of the potential economic effects on agricultural producers; and
 - (3) Any mitigation measures proposed to address potential economic harm.
