That of the amounts made available under this 16 17 heading, \$5,000,000 shall be made available for capacity 18 building and technical assistance, including assistance on contracting and procurement processes, to support States, 19 20 units of general local government, or Indian tribes (and

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their subrecipients) that receive allocations related to 1 major disasters under this heading in this Act or any Act 2 3 enacted before or after the date of enactment of this Act: 4 *Provided further*, That of the amounts made available 5 under this heading, \$10,000,000 shall be transferred, in aggregate, to "Department of Housing and Urban Devel-6 7 opment— Program Office Salaries and Expenses—Com-8 munity Planning and Development" for necessary costs, 9 including information technology costs, of administering 10 and overseeing the obligation and expenditure of amounts made available under this heading in this Act or any Act 11 enacted before or after the date of enactment of this Act 12 13 that makes amounts available for purposes related to major disasters under such heading: Provided further, 14 15 That of the amounts made available under this heading in this Act, \$3,000,000 shall be transferred in aggregate 16 to "Department of Housing and Urban Development-Of-17 fice of Inspector General" for necessary costs of overseeing 18 19 and auditing funds amounts made available under the heading "Community Development Fund" in this Act or 20 21 any Act enacted before or after the date of enactment of 22 this Act that makes amounts available for purposes re-23 lated to major disasters under such heading: Provided fur-24 ther, That amounts made available under this section and 25 under such heading in such Act may be used by a grantee

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to assist utilities as part of a disaster-related eligible activ-1 2 ity under section 105(a) of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5305(a)): Provided 3 4 *further*, That the Secretary's determination of unmet 5 needs should consider the best available data on the total cost to reconstruct destroyed properties: Provided further, 6 7 That such amount is designated by the Congress as being for an emergency requirement pursuant to section 8 9 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (2 U.S.C. 901(b)(2)(A)(i)). 10

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
