

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118–44**OFFERED BY MS. TOKUDA OF HAWAII**

Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. 5. REPORT.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Concurrent with the submission
3 of any convention, agreement, or other international in-
4 strument on pandemic prevention, preparedness, and re-
5 sponse as described in section 4, the Secretary of State,
6 in coordination with the heads of other relevant Federal
7 departments and agencies, shall submit to the relevant
8 congressional committees a report on—

9 (1) the impacts of such international instru-
10 ment on global health security;

11 (2) the impacts of such international instru-
12 ment on public health;

13 (3) consequences of failure by the United States
14 to ratify such international instrument on global
15 health security and public health; and

16 (4) consequences of failure by the United States
17 to ratify such international instrument on United
18 States foreign relations and other national security
19 interests, including United States influence at the

1 World Health Organization and other multinational
2 organizations.

3 (b) RELEVANT CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-
4 FINED.—In this section, the term “relevant congressional
5 committees” means—

6 (1) the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the
7 House of Representatives; and

8 (2) the Committee on Foreign Relations of the
9 Senate.
