Insert after page 208, line 23, the following new section:

1 **SEC. __. NORMAL TRADE RELATIONS TARIFFS ON AGRICUL-**
2 **TURAL INPUTS.**

3 (a) MAINTENANCE OF TARIFF RATE FOR AGRICUL-
4 TURAL INPUTS.—Notwithstanding any other provision of
5 law or regulation imposing tariffs on a country-by-country
6 basis, including any authority with respect to the imposi-
7 tion of tariffs under emergency situations, no tariff or
8 other duty may be imposed in excess of the rate assessed
9 as of January 19, 2025, with respect to any article classi-
10 fiable as an article described in subsection (b) that is im-
11 ported to the United States from a country to which the
12 United States has extended normal trade relations.

13 (b) AGRICULTURAL INPUTS.—An article described in
14 this subsection is any of the following:

15 (1) Seed, including corn, soybean, and wheat.

16 (2) Fertilizer, including nitrogen, phosphorus,
17 potash.

18 (3) Crop protection chemicals, including herbi-
19 cides, insecticides, fungicides.

1 (4) Feed for livestock.

2 (5) Fuel and energy articles, including diesel,
3 propane, electricity.

4 (6) Machinery and equipment, including trac-
5 tors, combines, replacement parts, specialty crop
6 harvesters.

7 (7) Building materials, including steel, lumber,
8 fencing.

9 (8) Veterinary supplies and medicines.

10 (9) Other inputs, including supplies and compo-
11 nents necessary for farm production.

12 (c) COORDINATION WITH USCBP.—The Secretary
13 of Agriculture shall coordinate as appropriate with the
14 Commissioner of U.S. Customs and Border Protection to
15 ensure that refunds of tariffs imposed through an asser-
16 tion of authorities under the International Emergency
17 Economic Powers Act (50 U.S.C. 1701 et seq.) and invali-
18 dated by the Supreme Court in *Learning Resources, Inc.*
19 *v. Trump* on February 20, 2026, are made available to
20 domestic producers on an expedited basis.
