AMENDMENT TO H.R. 910, AS REPORTED OFFERED BY MR. TONKO OF NEW YORK

In section 4 of the bill—

- (1) strike "and" at the end of paragraph (3);
- (2) strike the period at the end of paragraph(4) and insert "; and"; and
- (3) insert after paragraph (4) the following paragraph:

(5) in the year after the date of enactment of
this Act, Congress should hold Congressional, tele-
vised, field hearings (within 15 miles of at least 20
different stationary sources that, with respect to the
control of greenhouse gas emissions, would, if not
for this Act and the amendments made by this Act
be subject to requirements under the Clean Air Act
(42 U.S.C. 7401 et seq.) in accordance with the rule
entitled "Prevention of Significant Deterioration and
Title V Greenhouse Gas Tailoring Rule" published
at 75 Fed. Reg. 31514 (June 3, 2010)) to hear from
local residents regarding the impact that this Act
and the amendments made by this Act may have or
the health of such residents.
