Amendment to H. Con. Res. 34, as Reported Offered by Mr. Tonko of New York

At the end of title VI, add the following new section:

1	SEC SENSE OF THE HOUSE ON SAVING HEALTH CARE
2	FOR SENIORS, MILITARY, AND VETERANS.
3	(a) FINDINGS.—The House finds that—
4	(1) senior citizens and persons with disabilities
5	highly value the Medicare program and rely on
6	Medicare to guarantee their health security; and
7	(2) active duty military servicemembers and
8	their families value the high-quality health care they
9	receive through Tricare and other programs run by
10	the Department of Defense, and veterans rely on the
11	health service network run by the Department of
12	Veterans Affairs to address their unique health
13	needs.
14	(b) SENSE OF THE HOUSE.—It is the sense of the
15	House that—
16	(1) the Congress should reject legislation that—
17	(A) protects tax cuts for the wealthy and
18	special interests while shifting health care costs

19 onto seniors through a policy to replace Medi-

1	care with vouchers or premium support for the
2	purchase of private insurance; or
3	(B) damages the excellent care provided to
4	the men and women who are serving and who
5	have served the country in uniform; and
6	(2) any future health care legislation that elimi-
7	nates quality Federal health care programs and—
8	(A) replaces them with vouchers or pre-
9	mium support for the purchase of private insur-
10	ance; or
11	(B) sets caps on Federal health care
12	spending,
13	should exclude programs for seniors, military
14	servicemembers and their families, and veterans.
