

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2213, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MRS. TORRES OF CALIFORNIA**

Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. 4. ESTABLISHMENT OF CPB-WIDE COMPLAINT MAN-**  
2 **AGEMENT SYSTEM.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Secu-  
4 rity shall implement the Homeland Security Advisory  
5 Council’s recommendation for the establishment of a U.S.  
6 Customs and Border Protection-wide method to receive,  
7 track, and respond to complaints. Such a complaint man-  
8 agement system shall include the specific recommenda-  
9 tions specified in the Homeland Security Advisory Coun-  
10 cil’s March 15, 2016, Final Report of the CBP Integrity  
11 Advisory Panel.

12 (b) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 90 days  
13 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary  
14 shall submit to Congress a report on the status of the im-  
15 plementation of subsection (a).

16 (c) ANNUAL UPDATES.—For each fiscal year, the  
17 Secretary shall include, together with the annual budget  
18 justification materials submitted by the Secretary to Con-  
19 gress, an update on the implementation of subsection (a).
