At the end of subtitle G of title XII, add the following:

1 SEC. __. CERTIFICATION RELATING TO ASSISTANCE FOR 2 GUATEMALA.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Prior to the transfer of any equip-4 ment by the Department of Defense to a joint task force 5 of the Guatemalan military or national civilian police during fiscal year 2021, the Secretary of Defense shall certify 6 to the appropriate congressional committees that such 7 8 ministries have made a credible commitment to use such 9 equipment only for the uses for which they were intended. 10 (b) ISSUING REGULATIONS.—Not later than 60 days 11 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary 12 of State, in coordination with the Administrator of the United States Agency for International Development and 13 the Secretary of Defense, as appropriate, shall issue regu-14 lations requiring the inclusion of appropriate clauses for 15 16 any new foreign assistance contracts, grants, and cooperative agreements covering the transfer of equipment to the 17 Guatemalan military or national civilian police, to ensure 18 that any equipment provided by the Department of De-19

fense to the Guatemalan military or national civilian police
 may be recovered if such equipment is used for purposes
 other than those purposes for which it was provided.

- 4 (c) EXCEPTIONS AND WAIVER.—
- 5 (1) EXCEPTIONS.—Subsection (b) shall not
 6 apply to humanitarian assistance, disaster assist7 ance, or assistance to combat corruption.

8 (2) WAIVER.—The Secretary of State or the 9 Secretary of Defense, on a case by case basis, may 10 waive the requirement under subsection (b) if the 11 Secretary of State or the Secretary of Defense cer-12 tifies to the appropriate congressional committees 13 that such waiver is important to the national secu-14 rity interests of the United States.

15 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES
16 DEFINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate con17 gressional committees" means—

18 (1) the Committee on Armed Services, the
19 Committee on Appropriations, and the Committee on
20 Foreign Affairs of the House of Representatives;
21 and

(2) the Committee on Armed Services, the
Committee on Appropriations, and the Committee on
Foreign Relations of the Senate.
