

**AMENDMENT TO**  
**RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118–10**  
**OFFERED BY MR. TORRES OF NEW YORK**

At the end of subtitle B of title XVIII, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 18\_\_ . REPORT BY DIRECTOR OF NATIONAL INTEL-**  
2 **LIGENCE ON UYGHUR GENOCIDE.**

3 (a) **COLLECTION.**—The heads of the elements of the  
4 intelligence community shall take such steps as may be  
5 necessary to ensure the timely and effective collection of  
6 intelligence relating to the Uyghur genocide.

7 (b) **REPORT ON UYGHUR GENOCIDE.**—

8 (1) **SUBMISSION.**—Not later than 180 days  
9 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Di-  
10 rector of National Intelligence, in coordination with  
11 the relevant heads of the elements of the intelligence  
12 community, shall submit to the appropriate congres-  
13 sional committees a report on the Uyghur genocide,  
14 including an analysis of any intelligence collected  
15 pursuant to subsection (a).

16 (2) **MATTERS.**—The report under paragraph  
17 (1) shall address the following matters:

1 (A) Forced sterilization, forced birth con-  
2 trol, and forced abortion of Uyghurs.

3 (B) Forced transfer of Uyghur children  
4 from their families.

5 (C) Forced labor of Uyghurs, inside and  
6 outside of Xinjiang.

7 (D) The work conditions of Uyghur labor-  
8 ers (including laborers in the textile, automobile  
9 and electric vehicle, solar panel, polyvinyl chlo-  
10 ride, and rare earth metals sectors), including  
11 an identification of any company that is—

12 (i) organized under the laws of the  
13 People's Republic of China or otherwise  
14 subject to the jurisdiction of (or over which  
15 control is exercised or exercisable by) the  
16 Government of the People's Republic of  
17 China; and

18 (ii) employing forced Uyghur laborers  
19 from Xinjiang.

20 (E) Any other forms of physical or psycho-  
21 logical torture against Uyghurs.

22 (F) Any other actions that infringe on the  
23 rights of Uyghurs to live freely in accordance  
24 with their customs, culture, and religious prac-  
25 tices.

1           (G) The methods of surveillance of  
2           Uyghurs, including surveillance via technology,  
3           law enforcement notifications, and forcing  
4           Uyghurs to live with other individuals for moni-  
5           toring purposes.

6           (H) Such other matters as the Director of  
7           National Intelligence may determine appro-  
8           priate.

9           (3) FORM.—The report under paragraph (1)  
10          shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may in-  
11          clude a classified annex.

12          (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

13           (1) The term “appropriate congressional com-  
14          mittees” means—

15           (A) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and  
16          the Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence  
17          of the House of Representatives; and

18           (B) the Committee on Foreign Relations  
19          and the Select Committee on Intelligence of the  
20          Senate.

21           (2) The terms “intelligence”, “intelligence com-  
22          munity”, and “national intelligence” have the mean-  
23          ings given those terms in section 3 of the National  
24          Security Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 3003).
