

**AMENDMENT TO**  
**RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118–11**  
**OFFERED BY MR. TORRES OF NEW YORK**

At the end of subtitle A of title V, add the following:

1 **SEC. 5 \_\_\_\_ . EXPANSION OF THE SCOPE OF THE LITHIUM**  
2 **BATTERY SAFETY ADVISORY COMMITTEE.**

3 Section 333(d) of the FAA Reauthorization Act of  
4 2018 (49 U.S.C. 44701 note) is amended—

5 (1) in the subsection heading, by striking “AIR”  
6 and inserting “TRANSPORTATION”;

7 (2) in paragraph (1), by striking “air safety”  
8 and inserting “multi-modal safety”;

9 (3) in paragraph (2)—

10 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “air”  
11 each place it appears;

12 (B) in subparagraph (B), by striking “and  
13 the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety  
14 Administration” and inserting “the Pipeline  
15 and Hazardous Materials Safety Administra-  
16 tion, the Federal Railroad Administration, the  
17 Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration,  
18 and the United States Coast Guard”;

1 (C) in subparagraph (D)(i), by striking  
2 “and the ICAO Technical Instructions” and in-  
3 serting “, the ICAO Technical Instructions,  
4 United Nations Model Regulations, and the  
5 International Maritime Dangerous Goods  
6 Code”;

7 (D) in subparagraph (E)—

8 (i) by striking “air”; and

9 (ii) by striking “and” at the end;

10 (E) in subparagraph (F)—

11 (i) by striking “air shipment” and in-  
12 serting “shipment”; and

13 (ii) by striking “air transport.” and  
14 inserting “all modes of transport;”; and

15 (F) by adding at the end the following:

16 “(G) focus on enhancing emergency re-  
17 sponse for automated vehicles and grid-type en-  
18 ergy storage applications; and

19 “(H) provide a forum for the Secretary to  
20 better understand the lithium battery life cycle,  
21 including the safe transportation for disposal or  
22 recycling.”;

23 (4) in paragraph (3)—

24 (A) in subparagraph (A)—

1 (i) in clause (x), by striking “and” at  
2 the end; and

3 (ii) by striking clause (xi) and insert-  
4 ing the following:

5 “(xi) employees of the Department of  
6 Transportation, including employees of the  
7 Federal Aviation Administration, the Pipe-  
8 line and Hazardous Materials Safety Ad-  
9 ministration, the Federal Railroad Admin-  
10 istration, and the Federal Motor Carrier  
11 Safety Administration;

12 “(xii) retailers of products powered by  
13 lithium metal batteries;

14 “(xiii) employees of the Coast Guard;  
15 and

16 “(xiv) consumer or public interest  
17 groups.”; and

18 (B) in subparagraph (B), by inserting “the  
19 Consumer Product Safety Commission and”  
20 after “Representatives of”;

21 (5) in paragraph (4)—

22 (A) in the matter preceding subparagraph  
23 (A), by inserting “and annually thereafter,”  
24 after “establishment of the Committee,”; and

1 (B) in subparagraph (A)(i), by striking  
2 “air” and inserting “any mode”; and  
3 (6) in paragraph (7), by striking “air” and in-  
4 serting “transportation”.
