

AMENDMENT TO DIVISION E OF RULES

At the end of title LIII of division E, add the following:

1 **SEC. 5306. SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE REPORT ON IM-**
2 **PROVING SUPPLY CHAIN SHORTFALLS AND**
3 **INFRASTRUCTURE NEEDS AT WHOLESALE**
4 **PRODUCE MARKETS.**

5 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Not later than one year after the
6 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Agri-
7 culture shall submit to the appropriate congressional com-
8 mittees a report on—

9 (1) the 5 largest wholesale produce markets by
10 annual sales and volume over the preceding 4 cal-
11 endar years; and

12 (2) a representative sample of 8 wholesale
13 produce markets that are not among the largest
14 wholesale produce markets.

15 (b) **CONTENTS.**—The report under subsection (a)
16 shall contain the following:

1 (1) An analysis of the supply chain shortfalls in
2 each wholesale produce market identified under sub-
3 section (a), which shall include an analysis of the
4 following:

5 (A) State of repair of infrastructure, in-
6 cluding roads, food storage units, and refueling
7 stations.

8 (B) Sustainability infrastructure, including
9 the following:

10 (i) Carbon emission reduction tech-
11 nology.

12 (ii) On-site green refueling stations.

13 (iii) Disaster preparedness.

14 (C) Disaster preparedness, including with
15 respect to cyber attacks, weather events, and
16 terrorist attacks.

17 (D) Disaster recovery systems, including
18 coordination with State and Federal agencies.

19 (2) A description of any actions the Secretary
20 recommends be taken as a result of the analysis
21 under paragraph (1).

22 (3) Recommendations, as appropriate, for
23 wholesale produce market owners and operators, and
24 State and local entities to improve the supply chain
25 shortfalls identified under paragraph (1).

1 (4) Proposals, as appropriate, for legislative ac-
2 tions and funding needed to improve the supply
3 chain shortfalls.

4 (c) CONSULTATION.—In completing the report under
5 subsection (a), the Secretary of Agriculture shall consult
6 with the Secretary of Transportation, the Secretary of
7 Homeland Security, wholesale produce market owners and
8 operators, State and local entities, and other agencies or
9 stakeholders, as determined appropriate by the Secretary.

10 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES.—
11 For the purposes of this section, the term “appropriate
12 congressional committees” means the Committee on Agri-
13 culture, the Committee on Homeland Security, and the
14 Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the
15 House of Representatives and the Committee on Com-
16 merce, Science, and Technology, the Committee on Home-
17 land Security and Governmental Affairs, and the Com-
18 mittee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry of the Sen-
19 ate.
