Page 1348, after line 23, insert the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . BUREAU OF ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, FIREARMS,**
2 **AND EXPLOSIVES REPORT ON FIREARMS**
3 **TRAFFICKING ALONG THE I-95 CORRIDOR.**

4 Not later than 1 year after the date of the enactment
5 of this Act, and annually thereafter, the Director of the
6 Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives, in
7 consultation with State and local law enforcement entities,
8 and other agencies or stakeholders as determined appro-
9 priate by the Director, shall submit to the Committee on
10 Judiciary of the House of Representatives and the Com-
11 mittee on Judiciary of the Senate a report on firearms
12 trafficked along Interstate 95 that contains the following:

13 (1) An analysis of the number of firearms traf-
14 ficked along Interstate 95, that contains the fol-
15 lowing:

16 (A) Firearms listed by the State of origin,
17 and the make and model of the firearm.

18 (B) An analysis of the effectiveness of
19 counter firearm trafficking measures.

1 (C) An analysis of specific local, State and
2 Federal laws that affect the number of firearms
3 trafficked.

4 (D) A description of any actions directed
5 as a result of the analysis conducted under this
6 section.

7 (2) Recommendations, as appropriate, for Fed-
8 eral, State and local law enforcement entities to im-
9 prove firearm trafficking measures referred to in
10 paragraph (1).

11 (3) Proposals, as appropriate, for legislative ac-
12 tions and funding needed to improve measures to
13 counter firearm trafficking.
