Page 705, after line 3, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 1640. APPALACHIAN DEVELOPMENT HIGHWAY SYS-**  
2 **TEM.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—There are authorized to be appro-  
4 priated out of the Highway Trust Fund (other than the  
5 Mass Transit Account) for the Appalachian development  
6 highway system under subtitle IV of title 40, United  
7 States Code—

8 (1) \$250,000,000 for fiscal year 2022;

9 (2) \$300,000,000 for fiscal year 2023;

10 (3) \$350,000,000 for fiscal year 2024;

11 (4) \$400,000,000 for fiscal year 2025; and

12 (5) \$450,000,000 for fiscal year 2026.

13 (b) APPORTIONMENT.—The Secretary shall appor-  
14 tion funds made available under subsection (a) for each  
15 of fiscal years 2022 through 2026 among the States with  
16 unfinished Appalachian development highway system cor-  
17 ridors or unconverted “Advance Construction” amounts  
18 using the readiness apportionment methodology described  
19 in the report of the Appalachian Regional Commission en-

1 titled “Appalachian Development Highway System  
2 Planned Construction for 2021 to 2030 Report”, or a sub-  
3 sequent revised report, subject to the requirements that—

4 (1) each such State receives an amount of not  
5 less than \$20,000,000 for each fiscal year; and

6 (2) a State shall not receive an apportionment  
7 that exceeds—

8 (A) the remaining funds needed to com-  
9 plete the Appalachian development highway cor-  
10 ridor or corridors in the State, as identified in  
11 the latest available cost to complete estimate for  
12 the system prepared by the Appalachian Re-  
13 gional Commission; or

14 (B) 30 percent of the total amount made  
15 available under subsection (a) for the fiscal  
16 year.

17 (c) TREATMENT.—Amounts made available under  
18 subsection (a) shall be available for obligation in the same  
19 manner as if apportioned under chapter 1 of title 23,  
20 United States Code, except that—

21 (1) the Federal share of the cost of any project  
22 carried out with those amounts shall be determined  
23 in accordance with section 14501 of title 40, United  
24 States Code; and

25 (2) the amounts—

1                   (A) shall be available to construct high-  
2                   ways and access roads under section 14501 of  
3                   title 40, United States Code; and

4                   (B) shall remain available until expended.
