

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118–36**  
**OFFERED BY MR. TRONE OF MARYLAND**

At the end of subtitle C of title XVII, add the following:

1 **SEC. 17 \_\_\_\_ . DISPOSITION OF WEAPONS AND MATERIEL IN**  
2 **TRANSIT FROM IRAN TO HOUTHIS IN YEMEN.**

3 (a) DISPOSITION OF WEAPONS AND MATERIEL.—  
4 The President may treat as stocks of the United States  
5 any weapon or materiel seized by the United States while  
6 in transit from the Islamic Republic of Iran to the Houthis  
7 in the Republic of Yemen.

8 (b) DRAWDOWN AUTHORITY.—Section 506(a) of the  
9 Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2318(a)) is  
10 amended by adding at the end the following new para-  
11 graph:

12 “(4) In addition to amounts otherwise specified  
13 in this section, the President may direct the draw-  
14 down of weapons and materiel treated as stocks of  
15 the United States, seized pursuant to section  
16 17\_\_\_\_(a) of the National Defense Authorization  
17 Act for Fiscal Year 2025, to be provided to  
18 Ukraine.”.

1 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date  
2 of the enactment of this Act, and every year thereafter,  
3 the President shall submit to the appropriate congres-  
4 sional committees a report that includes the following:

5 (1) The number of times the President exer-  
6 cised the authority described in subsection (a).

7 (2) An inventory of the weapons and materiel  
8 treated as United States stocks under the authority  
9 described in subsection (a).

10 (3) An inventory of the weapons and materiel  
11 provided to Ukraine under the authority described in  
12 the amendment made in subsection (b).

13 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES  
14 DEFINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate con-  
15 gressional committees” means—

16 (1) the congressional defense committees;

17 (2) the Committee on the Judiciary and the  
18 Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate; and

19 (3) the Committee on the Judiciary and the  
20 Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-  
21 resentatives.
