At the end of subtitle C of title XVII, add the following:

## SEC. \_. STRATEGY FOR THE EXPANSION OF TRADE TRANS PARENCY UNITS.

3 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of the Con4 gress that Trade Transparency Units are a critical bilat5 eral and multilateral tool to identify, disrupt, and dis6 mantle international money laundering networks.

7 (b) Strategy.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days 9 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-10 retary of Homeland Security, in coordination with 11 the Secretary of State, shall submit the strategy de-12 scribed in paragraph (2) to the appropriate congres-13 sional committees.

14 (2) STRATEGY DESCRIBED.—The strategy de15 scribed in this paragraph is a strategy to—

16 (A) expand information sharing between
17 United States and foreign customs agencies
18 through Trade Transparency Units; and

(B) improve intra-agency, inter-agency,
 and multilateral information sharing with re spect to Trade Transparency Units.

4 (3) FORM.—The strategy required by this sub5 section shall be submitted in unclassified form and
6 may contain a classified annex.

7 (c) REPORT FROM THE OFFICE OF THE COMP-8 TROLLER GENERAL.—Not later 180 days after the date 9 on which the strategy required by subsection (b) is sub-10 mitted to the appropriate congressional committees, the 11 Comptroller General of the United States shall submit to 12 the appropriate congressional committees a report with an 13 assessment of the strategy.

14 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES
15 DEFINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate con16 gressional committees" means—

17 (1) the Committee on Homeland Security and
18 the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of
19 Representatives; and

20 (2) the Committee on Homeland Security and
21 Governmental Affairs and the Committee on Foreign
22 Relations of the Senate.
