Amendment to Rules Comm. Print 117–13 Offered by Mr. Turner of Ohio

At the end of title XXIII, add the following new section:

1 SEC. 23 . MILITARY CONSTRUCTION PROJECT TO SUP-2 PORT FOREIGN MILITARY SALES PROGRAM. 3 (a) PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND AUTHORIZATION.— 4 Using not more than \$100,000,000 of the funds derived 5 from charges for administrative services pursuant to sec-6 tion 21(e)(1)(A) of the Arms Export Control Act (22) U.S.C. 2761(e)(1)(A)), the Secretary of the Air Force may 7 commence planning and design for and construction of a 8 9 foreign military sales facility and supporting infrastruc-10 ture at a secure location selected by the Secretary in the United States or its territories to address the most severe 11 12 facility shortfalls related to the mission of the foreign military sales program authorized by chapter 2 of such Act 13 (22 U.S.C. 2761 et seq.). 14

15 (b) REPORT AND CERTIFICATIONS.—Notwith-16 standing the authorization provided in subsection (a), the 17 Secretary of the Air Force may not commence actual con-18 struction of the foreign military sales facility and sup-19 porting infrastructure described in such subsection until $\mathbf{2}$

30 days after the date on which the Secretary submits 1 2 to the congressional committees specified in subsection (c) 3 a report certifying that the proposed foreign military sales 4 facility will— 5 (1) be constructed in accordance with the plans 6 and design and supporting information accom-7 panying the report; 8 (2) support the mission of the foreign military 9 sales program; 10 (3) address the most severe facility shortfalls 11 related to such mission; and 12 (4) provide the best value for satisfying such fa-13 cility shortfalls. 14 (c) SPECIFIED CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES.—The 15 Secretary of the Air Force shall submit the report required by subsection (b) to the following congressional commit-16 17 tees: 18 (1) The Committees on Armed Services of the 19 Senate and the House of Representatives. 20 (2) The Committees on Appropriations of the 21 Senate and the House of Representatives. 22 (3) The Committee on Foreign Relations of the 23 Senate.
