

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118-

10

OFFERED BY MR. TURNER OF OHIO

At the end of subtitle E of title I, add the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . NON-STANDARD COMMERCIAL VEHICLE PRO-**
2 **CUREMENT.**

3 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-
4 gress that—

5 (1) to maintain a fleet of 603 non-standard
6 commercial vehicles, the United States Special Oper-
7 ations Command will require a minimum of 100 ve-
8 hicles per year;

9 (2) the current budget request would only fund
10 the procurement of 56 non-standard commercial ve-
11 hicles, leaving a shortfall of approximately 44 vehi-
12 cles; and

13 (3) a non-standard commercial vehicle is the
14 only low-profile vehicle of the United States Special
15 Operations Command that meets the geopolitical re-
16 strictions of certain regions, is often the only vehicle
17 permitted for off base maneuver, and is in high de-
18 mand by the Special Operations Command end-user
19 community.

1 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 30 days after the date
2 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense shall
3 submit to Congress a report that—

4 (1) addresses the current end-user requirements
5 including the status of fielded non-standard commer-
6 cial vehicles that are at, or exceed, the three-to-five
7 year life cycle of such vehicles;

8 (2) identifies the impact on the non-standard
9 commercial vehicle shortfall to warfighter readiness
10 and safety and the remedial actions necessary to ad-
11 dress such shortfall; and

12 (3) identifies a budget plan and timeline for the
13 replacement of non-standard commercial vehicles
14 that are at or exceed the life cycle described in para-
15 graph (1) with newer non-standard commercial vehi-
16 cles.
