

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-54
OFFERED BY MR. TURNER OF OHIO

At the end of subtitle B of title III, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 3__ . ADDITIONAL SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS FOR**
2 **ENERGY PERFORMANCE GOALS AND ENERGY**
3 **PERFORMANCE MASTER PLAN.**

4 (a) **ADDITIONAL SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS.**—Sec-
5 tion 2911(e) of title 10, United States Code, is amended
6 by adding at the end the following new paragraphs:

7 “(14) The reliability and security of energy re-
8 sources in the event of a military conflict.

9 “(15) The value of resourcing energy from
10 partners and allies of the United States.”.

11 (b) **REPORT ON FEASIBILITY OF TERMINATING EN-**
12 **ERGY PROCUREMENT FROM FOREIGN ENTITIES OF CON-**
13 **CERN.**—

14 (1) **IN GENERAL.**—Not later than 180 days
15 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the As-
16 sistant Secretary of Defense for Operational Energy
17 Plans and Programs shall submit to the appropriate
18 congressional committees a report on the feasibility

1 and advisability of terminating energy procurement
2 by the Department of Defense from foreign entities
3 of concern.

4 (2) ELEMENTS.—The report under paragraph
5 (1) shall include the following:

6 (A) An assessment of the reliance by the
7 Department of Defense on foreign entities of
8 concern for the procurement of energy.

9 (B) An identification of the number of en-
10 ergy contracts in force between the Director of
11 the Defense Logistics Agency and a foreign en-
12 tity of concern or an entity headquartered in a
13 country that is a foreign entity of concern.

14 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

15 (1) The term “appropriate congressional com-
16 mittees” means—

17 (A) the Committee on Armed Services and
18 the Committee on Energy and Commerce of the
19 House of Representatives; and

20 (B) the Committee on Armed Services and
21 the Committee on Energy and Natural Re-
22 sources of the Senate.

23 (2) The term “foreign entity of concern” has
24 the meaning given that term in section 9901 of the
25 William M. (Mac) Thornberry National Defense Au-

1 thorization Act for Fiscal Year 2021 (15 U.S.C.
2 4651).
