1REINSTATEMENT OF EMPLOYMENT OF PERMA-2NENTLY AND TOTALLY DISABLED VETERANS3EMPLOYED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF VET-4ERANS AFFAIRS.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—With respect to each covered em6 ployee the Secretary of Veterans Affairs removed from em7 ployment during the period beginning on January 20,
8 2025, and ending on the date of the enactment of this
9 Act, the Secretary shall, notwithstanding sections 713 and
10 714 of title 38, United States Code—

11 (1) reinstate the employment of such covered12 employee;

13 (2) place such covered employee in the same po14 sition such covered employee occupied on the date
15 that is one day before the date of such removal;

16 (3) exempt such employee from the provisions
17 of this Act and the amendments made by this Act;

(4) exempt such employee from separation due
 to any reduction in force that occurs before January
 20, 2029.

(b) COVERED EMPLOYEE DEFINED.—In this section,
the term "covered" employee" means an employee of the
Department of Veterans Affairs who is has a service-connected disability rated as permanent and total.
