

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119–33**

**OFFERED BY MS. TLAIB OF MICHIGAN**

At the end of subtitle A of title XII, add the following:

**SEC. 12 \_\_. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO THOSE RESPONSIBLE FOR MASSACRES IN HONDURAS**

(a) PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS.—None of the funds authorized to be appropriated by this Act or otherwise made available to the Department of Defense for security assistance or security cooperation may be made available to any unit of the security forces of the Republic of Honduras found to be directly or indirectly involved in the May 21, 2026, massacre of roughly 20 people in the Colón department of Honduras.

(b) REPORT.— Not later than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act the Secretary of Defense, in consultation with the Secretary of State, shall submit to the Committee on Armed Services and the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Representatives a report describing the steps taken to investigate the May 21, 2026, massacre in the Colón department of Honduras, including any direct or indirect involvement of members or units of the Honduran security forces, and to ensure that those responsible are brought to justice.
