

## AMENDMENT

### OFFERED BY MRS. TORRES OF CALIFORNIA

Insert, at the appropriate place, the following:

#### SEC. \_\_. NOTIFICATION OF HUNGER STRIKE.

(a) NOTIFICATION.—The Secretary of Homeland Security shall submit to the congressional committees of jurisdiction a notification with respect to any individual who is engaging in a hunger strike while in custody at any facility operated by or for the Department of Homeland Security. Such notifications shall be submitted within 72 hours of indication that the individual has notified facility staff of the intention to engage in a hunger strike. The notification shall include—

- (1) the date, time, facility, and location where the hunger strike is to occur;
- (2) the name, age, nationality of the individual;
- (3) the stated reason, if any given, that the individual has engaged in a hunger strike; and
- (4) any health issues for that individual that arise as a result of the hunger strike.

(b) REGULAR UPDATES.—The Secretary shall provide regular updates to the congressional committees of jurisdiction regarding the status of any individual on hunger strike at a Department of Homeland Security facility.

(c) PUBLIC WEBSITE.—The Secretary of Homeland Security shall establish a publicly available website with information on each Department of Homeland Security facility in which an individual is on hunger strike. The website shall include—

- (1) the name of each facility where at least one detained individual has been on a hunger strike over the past 5 years;

(2) the total number of individuals on hunger strike at each facility over the past 5 years; and

(3) the stated reasons given by the individuals for a hunger strike at each facility.
