NO SAMSHA POLICY AGAINST SUBSTANCE ABUSE 6 TREATMENT FOR INCARCERATED INDIVID-7 UALS. 8 The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services 9 Administration shall not establish, maintain, or implement 10 any memorandum of understanding or other policy that 11 prohibits or restricts the Administration's provision or 12 support of substance abuse treatment or related services 13 for incarcerated individuals, so long as such provision or 14 support-15 (1) is statutorily authorized (by provisions of 16 law other than this section) for such type of treat-17 ment or services; and 18 (2) not statutorily prohibited or restricted with 19 respect to incarcerated individuals.
