RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118–10 OFFERED BY MS. TENNEY OF NEW YORK

At the end of subtitle F of title X, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 10 REPORT ON UNMANNED TRAFFIC MANAGE-
2	MENT SYSTEMS AT MILITARY BASES AND IN-
3	STALLATIONS.
4	(a) In General.—Not later than 180 days after the
5	date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense
6	shall submit to the appropriate congressional committees
7	a report that includes—
8	(1) a detailed description of the threat of aerial
9	drones and unmanned aircraft to United States na-
10	tional security; and
11	(2) an assessment of the unmanned traffic
12	management systems of every military base and in-
13	stallation (within and outside the United States) to
14	determine whether the base or installation is ade-
15	quately equipped to detect, disable, and disarm hos-
16	tile or unidentified unmanned aerial systems.

1	(b) Appropriate Congressional Committees
2	Defined.—In this section, the term "appropriate con-
3	gressional committees" means the following:
4	(1) The Committee on Armed Services, the
5	Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transpor-
6	tation, and the Committee on Foreign Relations of
7	the Senate.
8	(2) The Committee on Armed Services, the
9	Committee on Foreign Affairs, and the Committee
10	on Transportation and Infrastructure of the House
11	of Representatives.
