

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1163, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. THOMPSON OF CALIFORNIA**

Page 16, after line 5, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 8. OFFENSES INVOLVING CARES ACT UNEMPLOYMENT**
2 **INSURANCE PROGRAMS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 213 of title 18, United
4 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
5 lowing:

6 **“§ 3302. Offenses involving CARES Act unemploy-**
7 **ment insurance programs**

8 “(a) LIMITATION.—No person shall be prosecuted,
9 tried, or punished for a violation of, or a conspiracy to
10 violate, section 1028A, 1341, 1343, or 1956 if the offense
11 involved an unemployment compensation program estab-
12 lished under section 2102, 2104, or 2107 of the CARES
13 Act (15 U.S.C. 9021, 9023, or 9025), unless the indict-
14 ment is returned or the information is filed within 10
15 years after the commission of the offense.

16 “(b) APPLICABILITY ON CERTAIN OFFENSES.—Sub-
17 section (a) shall apply to an offense committed before the
18 date of enactment of this section if the statute of limita-
19 tions otherwise applicable to that offense under this title

1 has not expired as of the date of enactment of this sec-
2 tion.”.

3 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
4 for chapter 213 of title 18, United States Code, is amend-
5 ed by adding at the end the following:

“3302. Offenses involving CARES Act unemployment insurance program.”.
