(b) DISCHARGE REVIEW.—Section 1553(d)(3)(B) of
such title is amended by striking "or military sexual trauma" and inserting ", sexual trauma, intimate partner violence, or spousal abuse".

15 (c) DISPOSAL OF MATERIALS IN NATIONAL DE-16 FENSE STOCKPILE.—

17 (1) IN GENERAL.—The President shall dispose
18 of materials contained in the National Defense
19 Stockpile so as to result in receipts to the United

States in the amount of \$1,000,000 by the end of
 fiscal year 2020.

3 (2) TREATMENT OF RECEIPTS.—Notwith4 standing section 9 of the Strategic and Critical Ma5 terials Stock Piling Act (50 U.S.C. 98h), funds re6 ceived as a result of the disposal of materials au7 thorized for disposal under paragraph (1) shall be
8 deposited into the general fund of the Treasury.

9 (3) RELATIONSHIP TO OTHER DISPOSAL AU-10 THORITY.—The disposal authority provided in para-11 graph (1) is new disposal authority and is in addi-12 tion to, and shall not affect, any other disposal au-13 thority provided by law regarding the materials spec-14 ified in such subsection.

(4) DEFINITION.—In this subsection, the term
"National Defense Stockpile" means the stockpile
provided for in section 4 of the Strategic and Critical Materials Stock Piling Act (50 U.S.C. 98c).
