Page 212, after line 19, insert the following section:

1 **SEC. 530. INCLUSION OF INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE**

3 **RATIONALES FOR CERTAIN CLAIMS FOR COR-**
4 **RECTIONS OF MILITARY RECORDS AND DIS-**
5 **CHARGE REVIEW.**

6 (a) CORRECTION OF MILITARY RECORDS.—Section
7 1552(h)(1) of title 10, United States Code, is amended
8 by striking “or military sexual trauma” and inserting “,
9 sexual trauma, intimate partner violence, or spousal
10 abuse”.

11 (b) DISCHARGE REVIEW.—Section 1553(d)(3)(B) of
12 such title is amended by striking “or military sexual trau-
13 ma” and inserting “, sexual trauma, intimate partner vio-
14 lence, or spousal abuse”.

15 (c) DISPOSAL OF MATERIALS IN NATIONAL DE-
16 FENSE STOCKPILE.—

17 (1) IN GENERAL.—The President shall dispose
18 of materials contained in the National Defense
19 Stockpile so as to result in receipts to the United

1 States in the amount of \$1,000,000 by the end of
2 fiscal year 2020.

3 (2) TREATMENT OF RECEIPTS.—Notwith-
4 standing section 9 of the Strategic and Critical Ma-
5 terials Stock Piling Act (50 U.S.C. 98h), funds re-
6 ceived as a result of the disposal of materials au-
7 thorized for disposal under paragraph (1) shall be
8 deposited into the general fund of the Treasury.

9 (3) RELATIONSHIP TO OTHER DISPOSAL AU-
10 THORITY.—The disposal authority provided in para-
11 graph (1) is new disposal authority and is in addi-
12 tion to, and shall not affect, any other disposal au-
13 thority provided by law regarding the materials spec-
14 ified in such subsection.

15 (4) DEFINITION.—In this subsection, the term
16 “National Defense Stockpile” means the stockpile
17 provided for in section 4 of the Strategic and Crit-
18 ical Materials Stock Piling Act (50 U.S.C. 98c).
