At the end of title I of division C, insert the following:

## SEC. 115. GRANT PROGRAM FOR CANAL INFRASTRUCTURE FACILITIES.

3 (a) There is authorized to be appropriated to the Sec4 retary of the Interior, \$100,000,000 for each of the fiscal
5 years 2023 through 2026 for a grant program for the ac6 celeration and completion of repairs to canal infrastruc7 ture facilities in Reclamation States.

8 (b) A project eligible for funding under this section9 is a project with respect to which—

- 10 (1) repairs are major, non-recurring mainte-11 nance;
- (2) in the case of repairs to conveyance assets,
  the Secretary, or the Governor of a State, determines that the canal facility has lost 10 percent or
  more of its designed carrying capacity along some
  portion of the facility, as a result of land subsidence;

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(3) restoring carrying capacity of a conveyance
 asset would assist in meeting groundwater sustain ability goals defined under State law; or
 (4) a facility is owned or operated by a State

5 and meets the requirements of subparagraphs (1),
6 (2), and (3) above.

7 (c) The Federal share of the cost of carrying out an
8 activity described in this section shall not be more than
9 50 percent.

10 (d) The non-Federal share of the cost of carrying out11 an activity described in this section—

12 (1) shall be not less than 50 percent; and

13 (2) may be provided in cash or in kind.

(e) Funds authorized to be appropriated under thissection may not be used to build new surface storage orraise existing reservoirs.

(f) Federal funds provided under this section shallbe in addition to any and all Federal funding authorizedin statute for such purposes, and shall be non-reimburs-able.

(g) In this section, the term "Reclamation State" has
the meaning given such term in section 4014 of the Water
Infrastructure Improvements for the Nation Act (Public
Law 114–322; 43 U.S.C. 390b note).

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
