17	(B) in paragraph (2), by striking "a serv-
18	ice-connected disability of"; and

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(4) in subsection (d), as so redesignated, by striking "who has a service-connected disability".

3 ELECTRONIC FUND TRANSFER REIMBURSE-(b) 4 MENT.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall update 5 the payment system of the Department of Veterans Affairs to allow for reimbursements through electronic fund 6 7 transfer for hospital care or medical services furnished 8 pursuant to section 1724 of title 38, United States Code. 9 (c) Assessment of Contract for Provision of CARE.—The Secretary shall assess the feasibility and im-10 11 plications of entering into a contract with an appropriate 12 non-Department entity to build a network of non-Department entities to provide hospital care and medical services 13 pursuant to section 1724 of title 38, United States Code, 14 15 including implications for the administrative burden on 16 veterans eligible to receive such care and services.

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
