5	(b) Prohibition on Possession.—Section 922(g)
6	of title 18, United States Code—
7	(1) in paragraph (8)(C)(ii), by striking "or" at
8	the end;
9	(2) in paragraph (9), by striking the comma at
10	the end and inserting "; or"; and
11	(3) by inserting after paragraph (9) the fol-
12	lowing:
13	"(10) who, while a juvenile who had attained 15
14	years of age but not 18 years of age, committed an
15	act of juvenile delinquency that would have been a
16	felony if committed by an adult,".
