

**AMENDMENT TO RULES**  
**COMMITTEE PRINT 119-8**  
**OFFERED BY MR. VAN ORDEN OF WISCONSIN**

At the end of subtitle C of title V, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 5\_\_\_\_. PILOT PROGRAM RELATING TO INDIVIDUAL**  
2 **LONGITUDINAL EXPOSURE RECORD DES-**  
3 **IGNATION OF NEVADA TEST AND TRAINING**  
4 **RANGE.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to the availability of ap-  
6 propriations, the Secretary of Defense shall conduct a  
7 pilot program to carry out activities relating to desig-  
8 nating in the Individual Longitudinal Exposure Record  
9 the Nevada Test and Training Range as a location in  
10 which members of the Armed Forces were exposed to occu-  
11 pational or environmental hazard.

12 (b) IDENTIFICATION OF AFFECTED MEMBERS.—

13 (1) IN GENERAL.—In conducting the pilot pro-  
14 gram under subsection (a), the Secretary shall iden-  
15 tify members of the Armed Forces who were as-  
16 signed to the Nevada Test and Training Range on  
17 or after January 27, 1951.

1           (2) EVIDENCE.—In carrying out paragraph (1),  
2           the Secretary may accept documents or other evi-  
3           dence submitted by members described in such para-  
4           graph or family members of such members.

5           (3) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this  
6           subsection may be construed to require evidence re-  
7           lating to the identification of a member to be sub-  
8           mitted under paragraph (2) for such member to be  
9           identified as affected under paragraph (1).

10          (c) REPORTS.—Not later than one year after the date  
11          of the enactment of this section, and annually thereafter  
12          until the termination of the pilot program, the Secretary  
13          shall submit to the Committees on Armed Services of the  
14          Senate and House of Representatives a report regarding  
15          progress in carrying out such program.

16          (d) SUNSET.—This pilot program shall terminate on  
17          the date that is three years after the date of the enactment  
18          of this section.
