

**AMENDMENT TO**  
**RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-33**  
**OFFERED BY MR. VAN ORDEN OF WISCONSIN**

At the end of subtitle H of title V, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 5\_\_\_ . DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE EDUCATION ACTIV-**  
2 **ITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE MAPPING.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 108 of title 10, United  
4 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 2164d  
5 the following new section:

6 **“SEC. 2164e. PROCUREMENT OF EMERGENCY RESPONSE**  
7 **MAPS FOR SCHOOLS OPERATED BY THE DE-**  
8 **PARTMENT OF DEFENSE EDUCATION ACTIV-**  
9 **ITY.**

10 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense, acting  
11 through the Director of the Department of Defense Edu-  
12 cation Activity, shall prioritize the procurement of emer-  
13 gency response maps for Defense Dependent Schools to  
14 ensure, to the greatest extent practicable, compatibility  
15 with public safety systems in the event of an emergency.

16 “(b) REQUIREMENTS.—Maps procured under sub-  
17 section (a) shall—

18 “(1) be—

1           “(A) in a digital file format accessible  
2 through a standard or open-source file reader  
3 or image viewer on a laptop computer, tablet  
4 computer, smartphone, or other mobile plat-  
5 form;

6           “(B) verified through on-site walkthrough  
7 inspections by the entity producing the mapping  
8 data;

9           “(C) developed in coordination with indus-  
10 try partners possessing demonstrated expertise  
11 in emergency response mapping for schools;

12           “(D) capable of being updated, printed,  
13 and shared electronically;

14           “(E) accessible without a subscription fee  
15 or other restriction; and

16           “(F) verified for accuracy by a  
17 walkthrough inspection;

18           “(2) integrate with software used by Federal,  
19 State, and local public safety agencies;

20           “(3) not be stored in a data center outside of  
21 the United States;

22           “(4) display information oriented true north  
23 and on a coordinate grid; and

24           “(5) depict any floor of such site or such por-  
25 tion through overlaid, aerial imagery.

1           “(c) DEFENSE DEPENDENT SCHOOL DEFINED.—In  
2 this section, the term ‘Defense Dependent School’  
3 means—

4           “(1) a school operated under the Defense De-  
5 pendents’ Education System, as authorized under  
6 the Defense Dependents Education Act of 1978 (20  
7 U.S.C. 921 et seq.); or

8           “(2) a Department of Defense domestic depend-  
9 ent elementary and secondary school, as authorized  
10 under section 2164 of this title.”.

11          (b) BRIEFING.—Not later than 90 days after the date  
12 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense  
13 shall provide to the congressional defense committees a  
14 briefing on the plan of the Department of Defense Edu-  
15 cation Activity for procuring emergency response maps  
16 under section 2164e of title 10, United States Code, as  
17 added by this section.
