3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act, the Attorney General, act-4 5 ing through the Administrator of the Drug Enforcement 6 Administration and in consultation with the Secretary of 7 Homeland Security, the Secretary of Education, the Director of National Drug Control Policy, and such other 8 Federal, State, local, or tribal agency as may be appro-9 priate, shall establish and implement an informational 10 11 campaign to educate covered students on the dangers and risks of working with cartels or other transnational crimi-12 nal organizations. 13

(b) NATIONAL STRATEGY.—The Secretary of Home15 land Security shall establish and implement a national
