At the end of title I (page 3, after line 4) add the following:

1	SEC INTERAGENCY TASK FORCE ON HYDRAULIC
2	FRACTURING BEST PRACTICES.
3	(a) Establishment.—The Secretary of the Interior,
4	in cooperation with other State and Federal officials and
5	authorities, private industry, and academic officials, shall
6	establish a task force to facilitate and support the develop-
7	ment of a voluntary, industry-led set of standards, guide-
8	lines, best practices, methodologies, procedures, and proc-
9	esses for—
10	(1) geologic and hydrologic mapping and risk
11	analysis to demonstrate geologic suitability;
12	(2) construction, cementing, and casing of wells
13	that undergo hydraulic fracturing;
14	(3) robust operating and monitoring require-
15	ments;
16	(4) general water management associated with
17	hydraulic fracturing, including flowback and pro-
18	duced water recycling;

1	(5) practices for mitigating surface impacts as-
2	sociated with hydraulic fracturing; and
3	(6) environmental protection for gas production
4	operations and leases.
5	(b) Limitation.—Any set of standards, guideline,
6	best practices, methodologies, procedures, or processes
7	adopted by the task force shall not prescribe or otherwise
8	require—
9	(1) the use of specific solutions;
10	(2) the use of specific technology products or
11	services; or
12	(3) that products or services be designed, devel-
13	oped, or manufactured in a particular manner.
14	(c) DIRECTION AND CONTROL.—The task force shall
15	be under the direction of the Secretary, or the Secretary's
16	designee.
17	(d) Membership.—The task force shall be composed
18	of an equal number of Federal, State, industry, and aca-
19	demic representatives.
