AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2931, AS REPORTED OFFERED BY MS. VELÁZQUEZ OF NEW YORK

Add at the end the following new section:

1 SEC. 3. REPORT TO CONGRESS.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Upon making a determination
under section 2(b), the Administrator shall submit to the
Committee on Small Business of the House of Representatives and the Committee on Small Business and Entrepreneurship of the Senate a report on the proposed relocation
of any covered office that includes the following:

- 8 (1) The number of small business concerns lo-9 cated in the sanctuary jurisdiction served by the cov-10 ered office compared to the number of such concerns 11 located in area to which the covered office will be re-12 located.
- (2) A detailed summary of the data-driven criteria used to inform the decision to relocate covered
 offices located in metropolitan areas.
- 16 (3) An explanation of how a relocation under17 this Act will better serve small business concerns.
- 18 (4) A detailed list of the district offices of the19 Administration that may be impacted by this Act.

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1	(5) A detailed explanation of the plans to main-
2	tain the provision of services of the Administration
3	during and after relocations made under this Act,
4	particularly in metropolitan areas that are major
5	economic centers.
6	(6) A detailed summary of the timeline for the
7	proposed relocations.
8	(7) A detailed list, including names and titles of
9	the employees for each covered office to be relocated.
10	(8) A summary of established clear, outcome-
11	oriented goals and performance measures for the
12	proposed relocations.
13	(9) An explanation of the extent to which such
14	goals align with the mission of the Administration
15	to—
16	(A) aid, counsel, assist, and protect the in-
17	terests of small business concerns;
18	(B) preserve free competitive enterprises;
19	and
20	(C) maintain and strengthen the overall
21	economy of the nation.
22	(10) An identification of the individuals respon-
23	sible for carrying out a proposed relocation under
24	this Act and the resources required for such reloca-
25	tion, including a detailed summary of the experience

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- of such individuals and the ability of such individ uals to manage the relocation process.
- 3 (11) A description of the outreach and engage4 ment the Administrator conducted for small business
 5 concerns located in sanctuary jurisdictions, and the
 6 input of such concerns on the proposed relocation.
- 7 (12) A detailed and comprehensive estimate of
 8 the cost of the proposed relocations and an expla9 nation of the funding for costs associated with such
 10 relocations.

(b) PROHIBITION.—The Administrator may not relocate a covered office before the day after the date on which
Administrator submits the report required by subsection
(a).

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
