After section 104, insert the following:

**1 SEC. 104A. AMENDMENTS TO SPECIAL SUPPLEMENTAL NU-**  
**2 TRITION PROGRAM.**

**3 (a) SPECIAL SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION PROGRAM**  
**4 FOR WOMEN, INFANTS, AND CHILDREN.—**Section 17 of  
**5 the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. 1786) is**  
**6 amended—**

**7 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “drug abuse”**  
**8 and inserting “substance use disorder”;**

**9 (2) in subsection (b)—**

**10 (A) in paragraph (8), by striking “drug**  
**11 abuse” and inserting “substance use disorder”;**  
**12 and**

**13 (B) in paragraph (16)—**

**14 (i) in the matter preceding subpara-**  
**15 graph (A), by striking “Drug abuse edu-**  
**16 cation” and inserting “Substance use dis-**  
**17 order education”;**

**18 (ii) in subparagraph (A), by striking**  
**19 “dangers of drug abuse” and inserting**

1 “harm of substance use during pregnancy  
2 and lactation”; and

3 (iii) in subparagraph (B)—

4 (I) by striking “are suspected  
5 drug abusers” and inserting “may  
6 have a substance use disorder”;

7 (II) by striking “drug abuse clin-  
8 ics,”; and

9 (III) by striking “drug abuse  
10 professionals” and inserting “re-  
11 sources”;

12 (3) in subsection (e)—

13 (A) in paragraph (1)—

14 (i) by striking “drug abuse” each  
15 place it appears and inserting “substance  
16 use disorder”; and

17 (ii) by striking “effects of drug” and  
18 inserting “effects of a substance use dis-  
19 order”; and

20 (B) in paragraph (5), by striking “sub-  
21 stance abuse” and inserting “substance use dis-  
22 order”;

23 (4) in subsection (f)—

1 (A) in paragraph (1)(C)(ix), by striking  
2 “drugs” and inserting “illicit or other harmful  
3 substances”; and

4 (B) in paragraph (13), by striking “drug  
5 abuse education” and inserting “substance use  
6 disorder education”;

7 (5) in subsection (k)(1)—

8 (A) by striking “1 member” and inserting  
9 “one member”; and

10 (B) by striking “drug abuse” and inserting  
11 “substance use disorder”; and

12 (6) by redesignating subsections (l) through (q)  
13 as subsections (m) through (r), respectively, and by  
14 inserting after subsection (k) the following:

15 “(l) ACTIVITIES TO SUPPORT WIC-ELIGIBLE INDIV-  
16 IDUALS IMPACTED BY SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER.—

17 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall—

18 “(A) develop and disseminate nutrition  
19 education materials for individuals eligible for  
20 the program; and

21 “(B) conduct outreach to individuals who  
22 are potentially eligible for the program and who  
23 are impacted by a substance use disorder.

24 “(2) PURPOSE.—The purpose of this subsection  
25 is to ensure that individuals participating in the pro-

1       gram who are impacted by a substance use disorder  
2       receive accurate nutrition education from trained  
3       staff in an effective and unbiased manner.

4               “(3) NUTRITION EDUCATION MATERIALS.—

5               “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall  
6       collaborate with the Secretary of Health and  
7       Human Services to develop appropriate evi-  
8       dence-based nutrition education materials for  
9       individuals impacted by a substance use dis-  
10      order, including—

11              “(i) nutrition education materials for  
12              individuals with substance use disorder  
13              during pregnancy and in the postpartum  
14              period; and

15              “(ii) nutrition education materials for  
16              infants impacted by prenatal substance ex-  
17              posure and neonatal abstinence syndrome.

18              “(B) EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS UP-  
19      DATE.—The materials developed pursuant to  
20      subparagraph (A) shall be included in the edu-  
21      cational materials developed under paragraph  
22      (15) of section 515(b) of the Public Health  
23      Service Act (42 U.S.C. 290bb–21(b)) and guid-  
24      ance issued under section 1005 of the SUP-

1           PORT for Patients and Communities Act (42  
2           U.S.C. 1396a note).

3           “(4)   NUTRITION   EDUCATION   CLEARING-  
4   HOUSE.—The Secretary shall make available to all  
5   State agencies through an online clearinghouse any  
6   nutrition education and training materials related to  
7   nutrition for individuals impacted by a substance use  
8   disorder or neonatal abstinence syndrome that have  
9   been produced by the Secretary or the Secretary of  
10   Health and Human Services (or produced by a State  
11   agency and approved by the Secretary), including  
12   educational materials developed under paragraph  
13   (15) of section 515(b) of the Public Health Service  
14   Act (42 U.S.C. 290bb–21(b)) and guidance issued  
15   under section 1005 of the SUPPORT for Patients  
16   and Communities Act (42 U.S.C. 1396a note).”.

17       (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section 17(q) of  
18   the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. 1786(q)), as  
19   redesignated by subsection (a) is amended—

20           (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “subsection  
21       (o)(1)(A)” and inserting “subsection (p)(1)(A)”; and

22           (2) in paragraph (2)(B), by striking “sub-  
23       section (o)(1)(A)” and inserting “subsection  
24       (p)(1)(A)”.
