## AMENDMENT TO

## **RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119–4** OFFERED BY MR. VINDMAN OF VIRGINIA

At the end of title I, add the following:

## 1 SEC. \_\_\_\_. OPIOID SALES TO MINORS OVER SOCIAL MEDIA 2 ONLINE PLATFORMS.

3 (a) STUDY.—The Secretary of Health and Human 4 Services acting jointly with the Attorney General (in this 5 section referred to as the "Secretary") shall conduct a 6 study on opioid sales to minors over social media online 7 platforms, especially those platforms that host user-gen-8 erated content.

9 (b) CONTENTS.—In conducting the study, the Sec-10 retary shall examine—

11 (1) the volume of opioid sales described in sub-12 section (a) distributed in the form of pressed pills; 13 (2) how opioid sales described in subsection (a) 14 have— 15 (A) resulted in accidental overdoses; and 16 (B) affected morbidity and mortality rates; 17 (3) the effectiveness of current laws, including 18 enforcement, in curbing opioid sales described in 19 subsection (a); and

(4) how website modernization tools are being
 used to curb opioid sales described in subsection (a).
 (c) REPORT.—Not later than two years after the date
 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall transmit to
 Congress a report containing the results of the study con ducted under this section.

7 (d) MINOR DEFINED.—In this section, the term8 "minor" means an individual 18 years of age or younger.

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
